RULES AND REGULATIONS

Teams will consist of 4 players

HANDICAP & AVERAGE

1. Individual handicaps shall be 80% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
2. Entrants must use the highest average of either their current average in any USBC league with at least 12 games, or last year's ending USBC book average. All others bowl scratch (220).
3. All averages will be verified by the Tournament Director
4. No reserved entries will bowl without payment in full.
5. Entry fees will not be refunded after entry closing date.
6. Additional squads may be added, if needed, before the end date of the tournament, at the Tournament Director's discretion.
7. Bowlers may compete more than once in Doubles provided they change partners.
8. Singles may only be bowled once.
9. Bowlers may compete more than once in Team event, but no more than 2 bowlers may bowl together more than once. All team entries must contain 4 names to be valid.
10. Doubles & Team entries may consist of any combination of Men and Women.
11. Singles will be bowled first.
12. All-Events entry is \$3.00. A bowler must bowl in all 3 events (T/D/S) to be eligible to compete in all-events prize.
13. A bowler's first score in each event will count towards All-Events.
14. All bowlers must show their current USBC membership card at check-in. Duplicate cards can be printed from www.bowl.com
15. Tardy bowlers will start to bowl in the frame in progress at the time of their arrival. No pins are awarded for missed frames.
16. Prizes will be paid 1 out of 4. All events will pay 1 out of 5.
17. "300" Jackpot – 300 game winners will receive ¼ of the current pot at the start of the day. Multiple 300's in the same game will split the ¼ number. At the end of the tournament, 300 game winners will receive equal share of the pot for each 300 shot. \$100.00 to be given to the first 300 of the tournament. (Must be in 300 pot to qualify)
18. "800" series Jackpot is \$3.00 per person, per event. 2 divisions, scratch and handicap. 100% payback
19. Optional Scratch Division \$5.00 per event, Payout is 1 out of 5.

PROTESTS

All rules not covered here will be covered by USBC tournament rules. All protests shall be handled by the Tournament Director. The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is filed within 72 hours in accordance with USBC Rules.
